The evening will sate your Scottish appetite and will be a full formal evening of Scottish fun. Come join in the grand celebration.

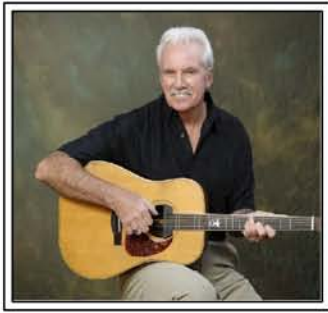
